

# AUGUST 24 & 25 – MADISON, WI TAKING THE REINS BARREL RACING SWEEPSTAKES PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

#### **TICKETS**

- Each TTR Barrel Racing Participant will receive (1) one-day wristband. Please check in at the Welcome Center Located in Barn 3. After signing a release of liability form, each contestant will receive his or her wristband.
- Any additional attendees, aside from the TTR Barrel Racing Sweepstakes participants, MUST purchase a wristband. Additional wristbands are available for purchase at the gate and at the Welcome Center. The cost is \$10 for a one-day wristband.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please review this essential information.

- Upon arrival, enter through the Main Gate and proceed to the horse check-in, located between Barns 1 & 4. After horse check-in is complete you will be directed to park your trailer and visit the Welcome Center, located in Barn 3, to sign your release of liability form and pick up your wristband. Please refer to the map enclosed.
- To ensure a timely check-in, plan on arriving at least 1.5 to 2 hours prior to the TTR Barrel Racing Sweepstakes. Please understand that arriving within an hour of the event increases your chance of having to wait for check-in due to the large number of participants.
- TTR Barrel Racing Sweepstakes participants are welcome to warm-up in the practice arena located behind barn 9. If you would prefer to warm-up on grass, please use the designated area indicated on the grounds map.
- All participants must adhere to the Midwest Horse Fair<sup>®</sup> Code of Conduct.

#### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

All equine animals entering the grounds for TTR must have the documentation listed below. The original and a copy are required for each horse entering the grounds.

- Original and a copy of the laboratory report of a negative equine infectious anemia (EIA) test conducted <u>after January 1, 2013</u> which clearly identifies the equine animal by registration number, lip tattoo, or a complete description of the equine animal.
- Original and a copy of the certificate of veterinary inspection issued within 30 days of MHF (after July 24, 2013) if you are coming from another state.
