

## BARREL EVENT PROTOCOL

The following guidelines have been put in place in accordance with the recommendations of the CDC and WHO regarding social distancing and public health. Exhibitors are asked to refrain from attending the show if they have been in contact with anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days, have a fever or other symptoms, or are immune compromised.

Exhibitors and others in attendance are strongly encouraged to wear masks.

## Facility

- People shall not congregate in groups larger than 5 people and must follow social distancing guidelines.
- This event is closed to the public, no spectators allowed. Please limit the number of people who come to the show with each exhibitor to essential people only.
- No dogs allowed in barns
- No chairs are allowed in any indoor arenas. All bleachers inside and outside will be closed. In the outdoor area, all people must be at least 6 feet off the rail and maintain proper social distancing with others.
- Restrooms Only one person may enter the restroom at a time. No changing allowed in the restrooms.
- Please keep your group gatherings to your trailers and limit them to no more than 5 people.
- When not competing or feeding your horse you are asked to stay at your trailer.
- Please park trailers 20 feet from each other.

## Exhibitors and show arenas

- Exhibitors must submit a signed liability release and waiver with their entry forms. No entries will be accepted without a signed waiver.
- People on foot must always keep at least 6 feet of space between each other.
- Arena entrance/exits will be arranged so that riders are not coming in close contact entering and exiting the arenas. Riders are to follow directions for entering/exiting. Loitering is not allowed around the gate areas.
- Riders shall follow social distancing guidelines at all times including, but not limited to the warm-up and show arenas.
- Respect the gate person's personal space and maintain proper social distancing when interacting with him/her.

- Only exhibitors entered and are in current drag of 5 that is working in the arena may be in the warm-up/holding area. Only one adult may accompany each exhibitor to the holding/warm-up area. No children on foot allowed in the warm- up/holding areas.
- No foot traffic allowed at the in-gate. Exception, one adult for each contestant may be in the area for safety purposes.
- Only 10 horse/rider at 1 time in warm up arenas please make sure you take turns

## **Show Office**

- Show office capacity will be limited to one person at a time. Children may not accompany adults to the show office.
- No contact option to limit interaction with the show office, email entries or send them via postal mail, along with all necessary
- No one other than staff is allowed in show office.

Pay Back

• All prize money will be paid thru PayPal on Sunday. If you do not have PayPal we will mail the winnings.
